FEDS has organized and run outdoor and indoor soccer programs for our members whose ages vary from 4 years old to adults. In 2009, 1365 of our community members played outdoor soccer and about 300 played indoor soccer.</p>

<p>Description of program</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outdoor soccer program for special needs people from 16 years old and up. Only 20 spots are available so register quickly. • This soccer program is being developed by our coaches and our head coach Rick Clayford and it is intended to be fun while exposing the players to some skills development, team play and exercise. It allows the participants to develop over time without any undue pressure or expectations. Players will be able to participate and develop at their own pace. • The program will accept special needs people who are physically capable of participating without any serious medical condition that would put them at risk. Please advice coaches of any important medical information that should be known. • Starting Friday May28th to August 13th (12 weeks) • Field used would be in the Fergus/Elora area and will be announced ASAP. • Weekly session will be on Fridays. All sessions will start at 7:15 PM and will last until 8:30 PM. Rain or shine.




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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cost for participants is \$110 per person, but our program sponsor Trade-Mark Industrial Inc. has offered to cover \$35 of the fee for each participant. So, the net cost per person is \$75 for this season. • Soccer shirt/shorts/socks will be provided for all players. Sizes for participants will requested at registration. • A Support Person for participants must remain at the field during each session. • Weekly session would include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Initial warm up: Walking or running with or without help around the field with or without a soccer ball (10 minutes) ○ Formal warm up: Stretching and more formal exercises (10 minutes) ○ Basic Soccer Drills: Basic drills (15 minutes) ○ Break: 5 minute break (social break, water and rest) ○ Soccer games: 1 or 2 games (as needed) for basic and advanced groups (35 minutes).
